

PRIZE STRUCTURE

- The total purse is \$20,000 based on 200 entries. Prize awards will be adjusted according to the actual number of entries. **All entry fees will be returned as prize money.**
- Order of finish is based on highest accumulated pari-mutuel earnings.
- In the event of a tie, prize money for those positions will be equally divided among entrants involved in the tie.

1st	\$10,000 <i>(50% of entry fees)</i>
2nd	\$4,000 <i>(20% of entry fees)</i>
3rd	\$2,400 <i>(12% of entry fees)</i>
4th	\$1,400 <i>(7% of entry fees)</i>
5th	\$700 <i>(3.5% of entry fees)</i>
6th thru 10th	\$300 <i>(1.5% of entry fees)</i>

WAGERING FORMAT

- Challenge wagering allowed on the full cards from Aqueduct, Gulfstream Park and Tampa Bay Downs
- Win, Place and Show (WPS) wagering only or any combination thereof.
- Minimum wager is \$10.00 per race; no limit
- Cannot wager on more than one (1) horse in any race
- Must bet a minimum of ten (10) races; no maximum

CONTEST RULES & REGULATIONS

- \$100 cash entry fee is **non-refundable**. An additional \$100 cash "betting card" purchase is required upon registration for "tournament bankroll." Personal checks, credit or debit cards will not be accepted. Entry fee includes daytime simulcast program and *Daily Racing Form*. You may pick up your *Racing Form* the day before the Challenge at the Clubhouse Teletheater or Patio Terrace Teletheater at Monmouth Park.
- Entrants keep all pari-mutuel winnings.
- Entrants cannot add additional cash to tournament bankroll. **Adding additional cash to bankroll results in automatic disqualification.**
- **Players on the leader board (top 25) CANNOT withdraw their balance until instructed by the contest director. Doing so results in automatic disqualification.**
- Maximum two (2) entries per person.
- Each player must bet a minimum of 10 individual races and must bet a minimum of \$10 per race.
- Contest wagering allowed on Aqueduct, Gulfstream Park and Tampa Bay Downs.
- WIN, PLACE, or SHOW wagers only or any combination thereof.
- Top 15 finishers in each SSC contest automatically advance to the SSC Invitational. Top two finishers in the SSC Invitational each earn an entry in the DRF/NTRA Challenge (NHC XIII) 2012, provided they are NHC Tour members.
- Multiple entries will be allowed in the SSC Invitational. If a player finishes in the top 15 in two (2) separate SSC contests, that player will have two entries in the SSC Invitational.
- The top two (2) finishers in the SSC Invitational receive round-trip airfare and hotel accommodations to the DRF/NTRA NHC XIII 2012.
- In the event of a tie for 15th place, the player selecting the most winners advances to the Invitational. If there is a tie for most winners selected, there will be a random drawing to select the Invitational player.
- If one of the top 15 finishers in a contest is unable to participate in the Invitational, the 16th place finisher from that contest will advance. If the 16th place finisher is unable to participate, the 17th place finisher will advance and so forth until there are 15 contestants from that contest.
- Players must place all wagers personally. No person shall directly or indirectly act as an intermediary, transmitter or agent in placing wagers for the player.
- All tournament wagers must be made on Self-Service Terminals (SST's) using your betting card and Personal Identification Number (PIN).
- No cancellations on any wagers for any reason after post time. In the event of a late scratch, contestants must follow NJRC cancellation procedures.
- All official track rulings will apply to horses selected for tournament play.
- Monmouth Park and Sportech, Inc. are not responsible for "shut-outs" or incomplete transactions. No exceptions under any circumstances. All wagers should be placed early to avoid being shut out.

- Monmouth Park is not responsible for lost or mutilated account cards.
- The decisions of the judges and the NJSEA in all matters or disputes relating to this handicapping challenge are final.

GENERAL RULES

- Must be 18 years of age or older by February 26, 2011 and have a valid ID to register and participate in the Challenge.
- Must be 21 years of age or older by January 1, 2012 to attend the DRF/NTRA Championship (NHC XIII) 2012.
- Winners are responsible for all applicable state and federal taxes and may be required to complete Form W-9.
- Participants agree to have their name or image appear in any publicity material (posters, newsletters, programs, etc.).
- Employees of the NJSEA, the NJRC and Sportech, Inc. are not eligible.
- Licensed horse owners, trainers and jockey agents are eligible to participate, but are required to identify themselves and any vested interest(s) they have in any tournament race(s) in writing by completing and submitting the enclosed horsemen's declaration form to tournament officials. All horse owners, trainers and jockey agents are ineligible to wager, for tournament purposes, on any race in which they have a horse(s) competing, and/or any other vested interest.
- **Failure to complete and submit the enclosed horsemen's declaration form to tournament officials will result in automatic disqualification with no entry fee refunded.**
- The NJSEA reserves the right to make changes to the contest rules and format as necessary.
