

COVID-19 RACEDAY PROTOCOLS

Ship-Ins:

- 1. Horsemen are strongly encouraged to make arrangements with a trainer on the Monmouth Park grounds prior to shipping in.
- 2. All ship-ins will go directly to the receiving barn.
- 3. Trainers/handlers of ship-ins, with proof of full vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test dated within 48 hours will have access to the receiving barn to tend to their runners.
- 4. All ship-in personnel must remain at the receiving barn without accessing the remainder of the barn area.
- 5. On Fridays, ship-ins must be on the grounds by 10 am. On Saturdays and Sundays, ship-ins must be on the grounds by 8:30 am.

Paddock:

- 6. Each horse is limited to no more than three (3) people in the paddock (groom, trainer and an additional stable hand if necessary).
- 7. No owners will be permitted in the paddock.
- 8. Everyone in the paddock must have face covering.

Winner's Circle:

- 9. Win photos will be limited to no more than four (4) people (jockey, groom, trainer and an additional stable hand if necessary).
- 10. No owners will be permitted in the winner's circle.
- 11. Everyone in the winner's circle must have face covering.

Claiming:

12. Claims will take place in the racing office. Only one (1) person will be permitted to enter the Administration Building to drop a claim slip. Successful claimants will be given their delivery slip on the front porch of the Administration Building from the racing office staff. All shakes will take place on the porch outside the Administration Building.
