

The King of the Turf Handicapping Challenge

presented by Daily Racing Form

The King of the Turf Handicapping Challenge at Kentucky Downs will consist of three (3) online handicapping contests taking place through Xpressbet and TVG/4NJBETS only. A \$400 contest (\$200 entry fee, \$200 bankroll) will take place on Thursday, September 1, 2022. A \$500 contest (\$250 entry fee, \$250 bankroll) will take place on Sunday, September 4, 2022. An \$800 contest (\$400 entry fee, \$400 bankroll) will take place on Sunday, September 11, 2022. Per the below rules and prize structure, each of the three individual contests will have an independent prize structure. In addition, at the conclusion of the final contest, the player with the highest aggregate three-contest total will be named the King of the Turf: National Turf Handicapping Champion.

ONLINE PARTICIPATION INFORMATION

- All players must declare their tournament ADW (Xpressbet, TVG or 4NJBETS) at time of registration. Players must have an existing account with ADW in order to participate in the contest.
- Each player will be assigned a temporary online handicapping contest account through either Xpressbet, TVG or 4NJBETS.
- Players will be provided login credentials to access account.
- Online accounts will be preloaded with tournament bankroll (\$200, \$250 and/or \$400).
- All contest wagers must be made through this temporary contest account. It is a player's responsibility to distinguish between contest and personal online accounts. At conclusion of contest play, remaining bankroll will be transferred to the player's personal online account.

Thursday, September 1 - \$400 buy-in (\$200 entry fee, \$200 bankroll)

WAGERING FORMAT:

- Challenge wagering allowed on the full card from Kentucky Downs.
- Win, Place, Show, Exacta and/or Daily Double wagering only.
- Must wager on a minimum of five (5) races. No max.
- \$40 minimum bet per race. No maximum.

PRIZE STRUCTURE:

All entry fees will be returned as prizes. All prizes listed are approximations. Exact prizes will be determined by the exact number of participants.

- Based on 150 entries, total prize pool is \$30,000. To consist of:
 - o 3 NHC Prize Packs (NHC seat, flight reimbursement capped at \$400, hotel stay)
 - o Top 10 Split \$12,100 cash
 - 1st - \$5,000
 - 2nd - \$2,000
 - 3rd - \$1,000
 - 4th - \$850
 - 5th - \$750
 - 6th - \$650
 - 7th - \$550
 - 8th - \$500
 - 9th - \$400
 - 10th - \$400
 - o Remaining cash (\$2,000) to National Turf Champ prize pool*

Sunday, September 4 - \$500 buy-in (\$250 entry fee, \$250 bankroll)

WAGERING FORMAT:

- Challenge wagering allowed on the full card from Kentucky Downs.
- Win, Place, Show, Exacta and/or Daily Double wagering only.
- Must wager on a minimum of five (5) races. No max.
- \$50 minimum bet per race. No maximum.

PRIZE STRUCTURE:

All entry fees will be returned as prizes. All prizes listed are approximations. Exact prizes will be determined by the exact number of participants.

- Based on 150 entries, total prize pool is \$37,500. To consist of:
 - o 1 BCBC Prize (\$10,000 entry)
 - o 2 NHC Prize Packs (NHC seat, flight reimbursement capped at \$400, hotel stay)
 - o Top 10 Split \$13,900 cash
 - 1st - \$5,800
 - 2nd - \$2,300
 - 3rd - \$1,250
 - 4th - \$1,000

 - o Remaining cash (\$3,000) to National Turf Champ prize pool*

PRIZE ALLOCATION:

- The Top 3 finishers (based on 150 entries) will select their prize (BCBC or NHC) from the prize pool in order of finish.

Sunday, September 11 - \$800 buy-in (\$400 entry fee, \$400 bankroll)

WAGERING FORMAT:

- Challenge wagering allowed on the full cards from Kentucky Downs.
- Win, Place, Show, Exacta and/or Daily Double wagering only.
- Must wager on a minimum of five (5) races. No max.
- \$80 minimum bet per race. No maximum.

PRIZE STRUCTURE:

All entry fees will be returned as prizes. All prizes listed are approximations. Exact prizes will be determined by the exact number of participants.

- Based on 150 entries, total prize pool is \$60,000. To consist of:
 - o 2 BCBC Prize (\$10,000 entry)
 - o 3 NHC Prize Packs (NHC seat, flight reimbursement capped at \$400, hotel stay)
 - o Top 10 Split \$19,100 cash
 - 1st - \$8,000
 - 2nd - \$3,200
 - 3rd - \$1,700
 - 4th - \$1,400
 - 5th - \$1,100
 - 6th - \$950
 - 7th - \$850
 - 8th - \$750
 - 9th - \$600
 - 10th - \$550
 - o Remaining cash (\$5,000) to National Turf Champ prize pool*

PRIZE ALLOCATION:

- The Top 5 finishers (based on 150 entries) will select their prize (BCBC or NHC) from the prize pool in order of finish.

* The National Turf Handicapping Champion is the player with the highest aggregate three-day bankroll once scores are combined from the three individual contests. Based on 150 entries in all three contests, the National Turf Handicapping Champion will receive a BCBC seat (\$10,000 entry). A player MUST compete in all three contests (Thursday, Sunday and Sunday) to be eligible to be named National Turf Champion. If a player does not participate in all three contests and finishes with the highest aggregate bankroll, that player WILL NOT be crowned National Turf Handicapping Champion. **If a player has multiple entries, each entry will be marked 1 or 2. In the case of multiple entries in all or any of the three contests – when it comes to the aggregate totals – entry 1 will be added to entry 1 and entry 2 will be added to entry 2.**

OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Players must be pre-registered with all entry fee and bankroll paid in advance. All TVG/4NJBETS participants must be pre-registered by noon on Wednesday, August 31 for the September 1 contest, noon on Saturday, September 3 for the September 4 contest, and noon on Saturday, September 10 for the September 11 contest. Xpressbet players must pre-register by noon the day of the contest.
- \$400, \$500 and \$800 tournament buy-ins are not refundable. Buy-in must be paid in advance.
- Entrants keep all pari-mutuel winnings.
- If an entire day(s) of racing is cancelled in its entirety due to weather or other reasons, the rescheduled date will take the place of the cancelled date.
- Should a contest race card be partially cancelled, if seven (7) or more races have been run, the contest will go official as-is and the minimum race rules (must bet five races) will be waived. If fewer than seven races have been run, the contest will be considered a “no-contest.” Players will be refunded their entry fee portion (half of full buy-in). The contest may be rescheduled at the discretion of Kentucky Downs management.
- Entrants cannot add additional cash to tournament bankroll. Adding additional cash to bankroll results in automatic disqualification.
- Maximum 2 entries per person.
- Must be an NHC tour member prior to the start of the contest to be eligible for NHC seats.
- If a player who is double NHC qualified finishes in a position where only an NHC seat is available to be selected, that player will receive the value of the NHC prize pack in cash in lieu of the seat, and the double-qualified player’s seat will not be awarded to the next finisher – provided at least two NHC prize packs are awarded.
- In the event of a tie for any position, the amount of winning win wagers will determine order of prize selection.
- Players must place all wagers personally. No person shall directly or indirectly act as an intermediary, transmitter or agent in placing wagers for the player. Additionally, collusion amongst players may serve as grounds for disqualification.
- All official track rulings apply to horses selected for tournament play.
- Kentucky Downs, Global Tote, and Amtote are not responsible for shut outs or incomplete transactions. No exceptions under any circumstances. All wagers should be placed early to avoid being shut out.
- The decisions of the judges and Kentucky Downs in all matters or disputes relating to this contest are final.
- Must be 18 years or older by September 1, 2022 to participate in the contests.
- Must be 21 years of age by January 1, 2023 to attend the 2023 National Horseplayers Championship.
- Winners are responsible for all applicable state and federal taxes and may be required to complete a W-9 Form.
- Participants agree to have their name or image appear in any publicity material.
- Employees of Kentucky Downs, the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, Xpressbet, TVG, Amtote and Global Tote are not eligible.
- Licensed owners, trainers or jockey agents may not wager on any race in which they have a vested interest and must declare said race(s) in advance.
- Kentucky Downs reserves the right to make changes to the contest rules and format as necessary.
- ODS Technologies, L.P. (TVG/4NJBETS) is not a sponsor of this challenge.
- Players participating through a TVG/4NJBETS account must meet TVG/4NJBETS’ account registration requirements, including age and residency requirements.
