PRIZE STRUCTURE

- All entry will be returned as prizes. The total prize structure, based on 125 entries, consists of \$8,000 in cash awards and \$17,000 towards the cost of two National Horseplayers Championship seats plus travel costs, four Pick Your Prize seats.
- Order of finish is based on highest accumulated pari-mutuel earnings.
- In the event of a tie, prize money for those positions will be equally divided among entrants involved in the tie.

1 st	\$4,000 (50% of cash awards)
2 nd	\$1,600 (20% of cash awards)
3 rd	\$1,200 (15% of cash awards)
4 th	\$800 (10% of cash awards)
5 th	\$400 (5% of cash awards)

WAGERING FORMAT

- Challenge wagering allowed on the cards from Monmouth Park, Aqueduct and Churchill Downs.
- Win, Place and Show (WPS) wagering only or any combination thereof.
- Must wager on a minimum of 10 total races. No max.
- Must wager on a minimum of five (5) Monmouth Park races.
- Minimum wager is \$20.00 per race: no limit.
- Cannot wager on more than one (1) horse in any race.

CONTEST RULES & REGULATIONS

- \$200 entry fee is non-refundable. An additional \$200 "betting card" purchase is required upon registration for "tournament bankroll." Personal checks, credit or debit cards will not be accepted. Entry fee includes daytime simulcast program.
- Entrants keep all pari-mutuel winnings.
- Entrants cannot add additional cash to tournament bankroll.
Adding additional cash to bankroll results in automatic disqualification.
- Players on the leader board (top 25) CANNOT withdraw their balance until instructed by the contest director. Doing so results in automatic disqualification.
- Max 2 entries per person.
- Each player must bet a minimum of 10 individual races and must bet a minimum of \$20 per race.
- Must wager on a minimum of five (5) Monmouth Park races.
- Contest wagering allowed on Monmouth Park, Aqueduct and Churchill Downs
- WIN, PLACE, or SHOW wagers only or any combination thereof.
- The Top 6 finishers pick between two NHC seats and four Pick Your Prize seats. Players who pick a PYP seat also receive a June 14 \$300 NHC contest seat.
- In the event of a tie, the player selecting the most winners gets the prize selection. If there is a tie for most winners selected, there will be a random drawing.
- Any player who already has two 2027 NHC seats, must select a Pick Your Prize seat. Any player who already has two 2027 NHC seats and two Pick Your Prize sheets, will receive \$2,000.
- Players must place all wagers personally. No person shall directly or indirectly act as an intermediary, transmitter or agent in placing wagers for the player.
- All tournament wagers must be made on Self-Service Terminals (SST's) using your betting card and Personal Identification Number (PIN).
- No cancellations on any wagers for any reason after post time. In the event of a late scratch, contestants must follow NJRC cancellation procedures.
- All official track rulings will apply to horses selected for tournament play.
- Monmouth Park and Global Tote are not responsible for "shut-outs" or incomplete transactions. No exceptions under any circumstances. All wagers should be placed early to avoid being shut out.
- Monmouth Park is not responsible for lost or mutilated account cards.
- The decisions of the judges and Monmouth Park in all matters or disputes relating to this handicapping challenge are final.
- In the event of a race(s) cancellation that causes a player to fall short of his or her mandatory minimum races, the minimum bet will be subtracted for each race under the minimum total. The player's official total will be their bankroll after the missing minimum bet(s) have been deducted.
- Collusion amongst players is strictly prohibited. If it is deemed collusion took place, tournament officials have the sole discretion to make a disqualification.

- Manipulation of the leaderboard is strictly prohibited. If, in the eyes of tournament officials, leaderboard manipulation has taken place, a disqualification can result.

GENERAL RULES

- Must be 18 years of age or older by May 30, 2026 and have a valid ID to register and participate in the Challenge.
- Must be 21 years of age or older by January 1, 2027 to attend the 2027 NTRA NHC.
- Winners are responsible for all applicable state and federal taxes and may be required to complete Form W-9.
- Participants agree to have their name or image appear in any publicity material (posters, newsletters, programs, etc.).
- Employees of Monmouth Park, the NJRC and Global Tote are not eligible.
- Licensed horse owners, trainers and jockey agents are eligible to participate, but are required to identify themselves and any vested interest(s) they have in any tournament race(s) in writing by completing and submitting the enclosed horsemen's declaration form to tournament officials. All horse owners, trainers and jockey agents are ineligible to wager, for tournament purposes, on any race in which they have a horse(s) competing, and/or any other vested interest.
- **Failure to complete and submit the enclosed horsemen's declaration form to tournament officials will result in automatic disqualification with no entry fee refunded.**
- Monmouth Park reserves the right to make changes to the contest rules and format as necessary.
